#### **A New Alternative to Decorative Chrome Plating**

Over the past several years, chrome has become an increasingly bad word in the metal finishing and environmental industries. This paper discusses a new alloy chrome substitute that has been developed to eliminate many of the drawbacks and limitations of earlier substitutes for decorative nickel using conventional electroplating techniques and operating procedures in rack or barrel equipment. The deposit is white/blue-white in appearance with neutral salt spray corrosion protection exceeding that of bright nickel-chrome deposits.
